The Secondary Section of our school proudly presents its Annual Report for the academic year 2025-26. 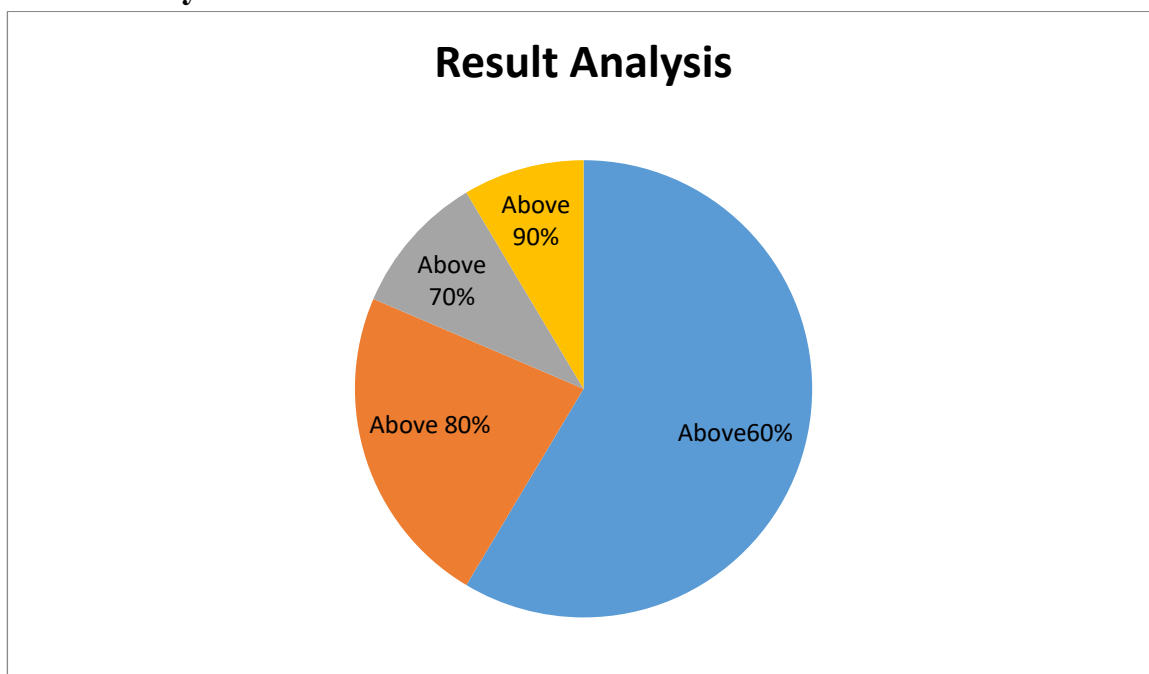
